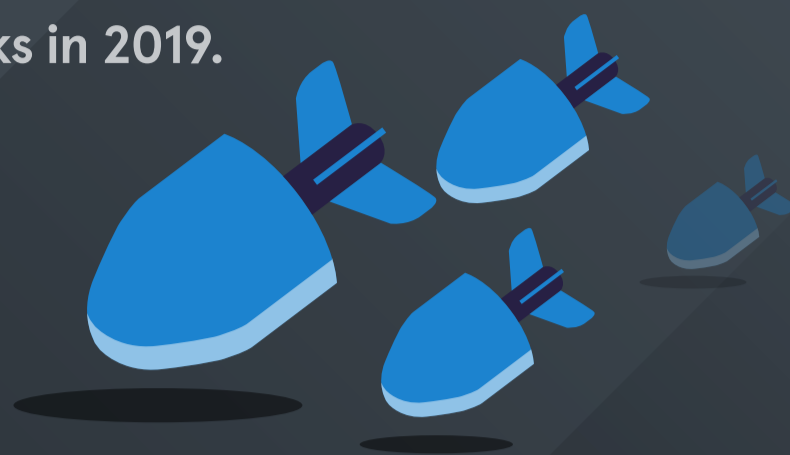
## THE HITS KEEP COMING

The *2019 The Year in Review, Cyber Threats and Trends Report* offers a unique view into the attack trends that are unfolding online, including attack statistics and behavioral trends. Here are some highlights:

There were many more DDoS Attacks in 2019.

**180%** increase

There was a pronounced increase, regardless of size, across the board.



Many attacks sneak in under the radar.

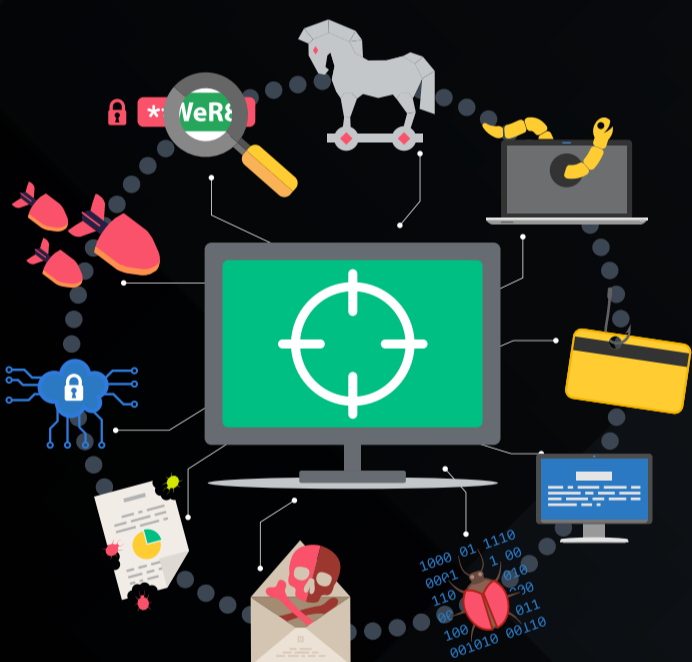
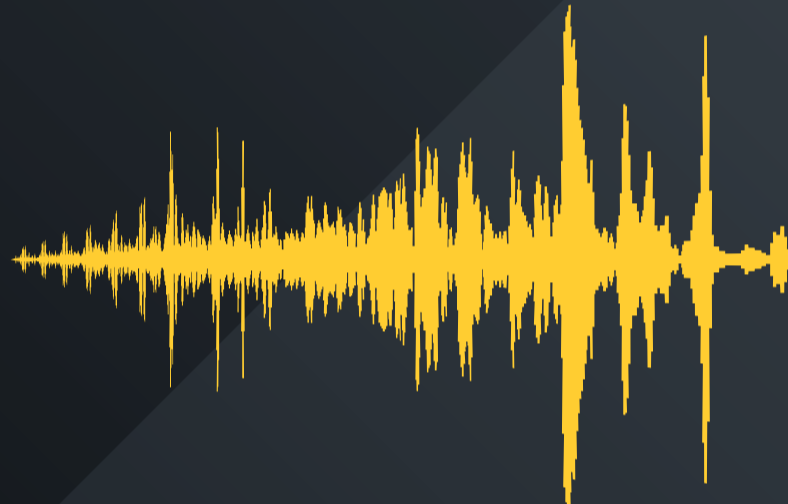
**75%** were 5Gbps or below

Smaller attacks may be used to mask a diversionary attack, like data theft or malware infiltration.

Attack intensity has grown.

**378%** increase in intensity Q4 2019 YOY

The longest, continued attack lasted over three consecutive days in 2019.



Multiple threat vectors are the norm.

**86%+** used two or more vectors

Neustar also observed a significant number of attacks that featured more than four threat vectors.

Web Application Attacks are on the rise.
